
Dear Parents:

I am writing to inform you that Campbell Middle School has been identified as in need of improvement. School improvement means that your school did not meet Ohio's goals in reading, math or attendance for two years in a row or more. The students at Campbell Middle School did not meet Ohio's goals in 5th grade math and reading; and 7th grade reading.

Once a school is in improvement status, parents are given a choice. Your child can attend a similar school that is NOT in need of improvement and the district will provide transportation if necessary. In Campbell Middle Schools' case there is not a second middle school in Campbell. Our next option was to see if there were any middle schools from communities that adjoined Campbell that were not in need of improvement. There are two, Struthers Middle School and Lowellville High School. Mr. Robey, The Campbell City Schools Superintendent, sent a letter to the Superintendents of Struthers and Lowellville asking if they would accept students from Campbell in their respective schools. Because of their own enrollments they respectfully declined to accept Campbell Middle School Students.

Our local report card [<http://ilrc.ode.state.oh.us/>] shows how well our Campbell Middle School did when compared with other schools.

To help Campbell Middle School get out of School Improvement, we have developed a plan to help our students do better in 5th grade math and 5th and 7th grade reading. You are invited to join us to help make it happen.
