## ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE CLASS OF 2017

This year, the Campbell Memorial High School Alumni Association is pleased to announce our scholarships of varying amounts which will be offered to qualifying seniors. Please review this information and apply for all of the scholarships for which you are eligible in the spring. Alumni Association staff members will meet with seniors in March to discuss our scholarships in detail and assist seniors with application forms. The time and date will be announced in Feb, 2017.

As of this date, the available scholarships are as follows:

### **The Nomiki Maillis Tsangaris Memorial Scholarship of \$1000.**

This scholarship is sponsored by Mr. Jack and Mrs. Melanie Maillis in honor of their aunt, Nomiki Maillis Tsangaris. This award will be given to a deserving senior who wishes to pursue a career in the trade industry. The student must attend an accredited school or university, have maintained a 2.5 GPA and write an essay detailing his/her interest and skill in the trade.

### **The Michael Elias Maillis/ Nicholas Ellinos Memorial Scholarship of \$1500.**

This award is sponsored by Atty. Michael and Mrs. Celeste Maillis. The recipient of this award must be a student who has attained a 2.5-3.4GPA and demonstrates future academic promise but has not yet reached his educational potential. The scholarship will be based upon a teacher's recommendation and the grade point average of the student. The teacher must seal the envelope and sign his/her name across the seal to ensure confidentiality. The student must also write an essay. An official copy of the student's transcript must also be submitted by the guidance office.

### **The Dr. Robert Ricchiuti Scholarship of \$1000.**

Sponsored by Dr. and Mrs. Robert Ricchiuti, this scholarship is awarded to a B+-C+ senior or a continuing education or post graduate student who takes great pride in his city and school. The applicant must write an essay on the topic: "What does growing up in Campbell means to me?"

### **The Ray Bragalone Memorial Scholarship of \$1000.**

Sponsored by the friends and family of Ray Bragalone, this scholarship will be given to a student who has been successful in the classroom and the athletic field. The family has devised a scholarship form which includes a 500 wd. maximum essay.

### **The Jack Wasko Scholar- Athlete Award of \$1000.**

The Wasko family sponsors this award given to a scholar athlete, who must submit a recommendation from a coach and completes a 300-500 word essay. Additionally, an application form must be completed.

### **The John Kovach Memorial Scholarship of \$1000.**

This scholarship, sponsored in memory of our founding president, John Kovach, by John's brother, Mr. Robert Kovach, will be given to a student who intends to pursue a degree at Youngstown State University and has garnered the highest grade point average in his/her class. The applicant must write a

**The Attorney Anthony Sgambati Memorial Scholarship of \$1000**

The Atty. Anthony Sgambati scholarship, sponsored by the Sgambati family, will be awarded to a graduating senior who has a family member who was/is active in a union. This could be any relative, e.g., uncle, grandmother, etc., in any union, steelworkers, teachers, nurses, etc. The applicant must submit an essay about the union member's involvement. Additionally, the applicant must have garnered a 2.5 GPA or higher.

**The Class of 1958 Scholarship of \$1000.**

This scholarship is sponsored by the members of the class of 1958 and will be awarded to a senior who has attained one of the top five grade point averages. An essay and application form must be submitted as well.

**The Frank Pietruch Memorial Scholarship of \$1000.**

This scholarship, sponsored by Nancy (Pietruch) Garland, will be awarded to a senior who wishes to pursue a degree in communications, speech, film or radio. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and submit an essay.

**The Dr. William and Mrs. Delores Suarez Scholarship of \$1000.**

Dr. William and Mrs. Delores Suarez sponsor this scholarship of \$1000 for a graduating senior who will pursue a degree in the medical field. The applicant must have maintained a 3.0 GPA, submit an essay and a recommendation from a teacher, coach or administrator and complete an application form.

**The Nicholas Alexander Memorial Scholarship of \$500.**

The Nicholas Alexander Memorial Scholarship, sponsored by the Campbell Belleria, is offered to a graduating senior who has maintained a 2.5 GPA or higher. In addition to an application form and a recommendation, the applicant must write a 300-500 wd essay addressing how growing up in a diverse community has influenced his/her future career goals.

**The Josephine (Grahovsky) Parise Musical Scholarship of \$500.**

This award, sponsored by the Parise family, will be given to a student who wishes to pursue a degree in music. The applicant will be requested to write an essay.

**ADDITIONAL AWARDS FOR 2017**

**The Dr. Richard Barr Scholarship OF \$2,000.**

This \$2,000 scholarship, sponsored by 1974 CMHS graduate and renowned radiologist, Dr. Richard Barr, will be awarded to a graduating senior who has achieved a 3.0 GPA or higher and plans to pursue a college education in the fall. This one year scholarship is renewable to a maximum of four years, provided the recipient meets the criteria set by the Dr. Richard Barr Scholarship Committee. This reward will be based upon the student's academic achievement, community involvement and extra-curricular activities. Additionally, the applicant must submit an essay and two letters of recommendation, one of which must be provided by a teacher.

**The Dr. and Mrs. Michael Pikos Scholarship of \$2,500.**

This scholarship, sponsored by Dr. Michael (class of 1968) and Mrs. Pikos, will be awarded to a

graduating senior who has attained a 3.0 GPA or higher and plans to pursue a college degree in the fall. This scholarship is based upon the student's grade point average, his/her academic achievements and awards, volunteerism, co-curricular activities, attendance and a teacher's recommendation. Additionally, an essay must be submitted.

**OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL SCHOLARSHIPS.**

**SENIORS.**

The Campbell Memorial High School Alumni Association's scholarships will be available online March, 2017. The deadline for submission is Friday, April 7, 2017.

Scholarship applications may also be obtained from and returned to Mrs. McCallister in the guidance office.

Furthermore, **ONE \$1,000 CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP** will be presented to a current CMHS alumnus who has completed at least one year of study at an accredited college or university. (Students attending for-profit or mail/internet institutions, such as University of Phoenix, do NOT qualify.) The student must currently maintain a 2.8 GPA or higher.

Also, the association is pleased to announce it will award **TWO POST GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP OF \$1000.**

These scholarships will be given to Campbell Memorial High School Alumni who have completed a four year bachelor's degree at an accredited college or university and are pursuing a degree of higher learning, i.e., a Master's degree, medical degree, law degree, M.B.A., etc. These scholarships will NOT be awarded to any person seeking certifications. Other criteria will be forthcoming.
